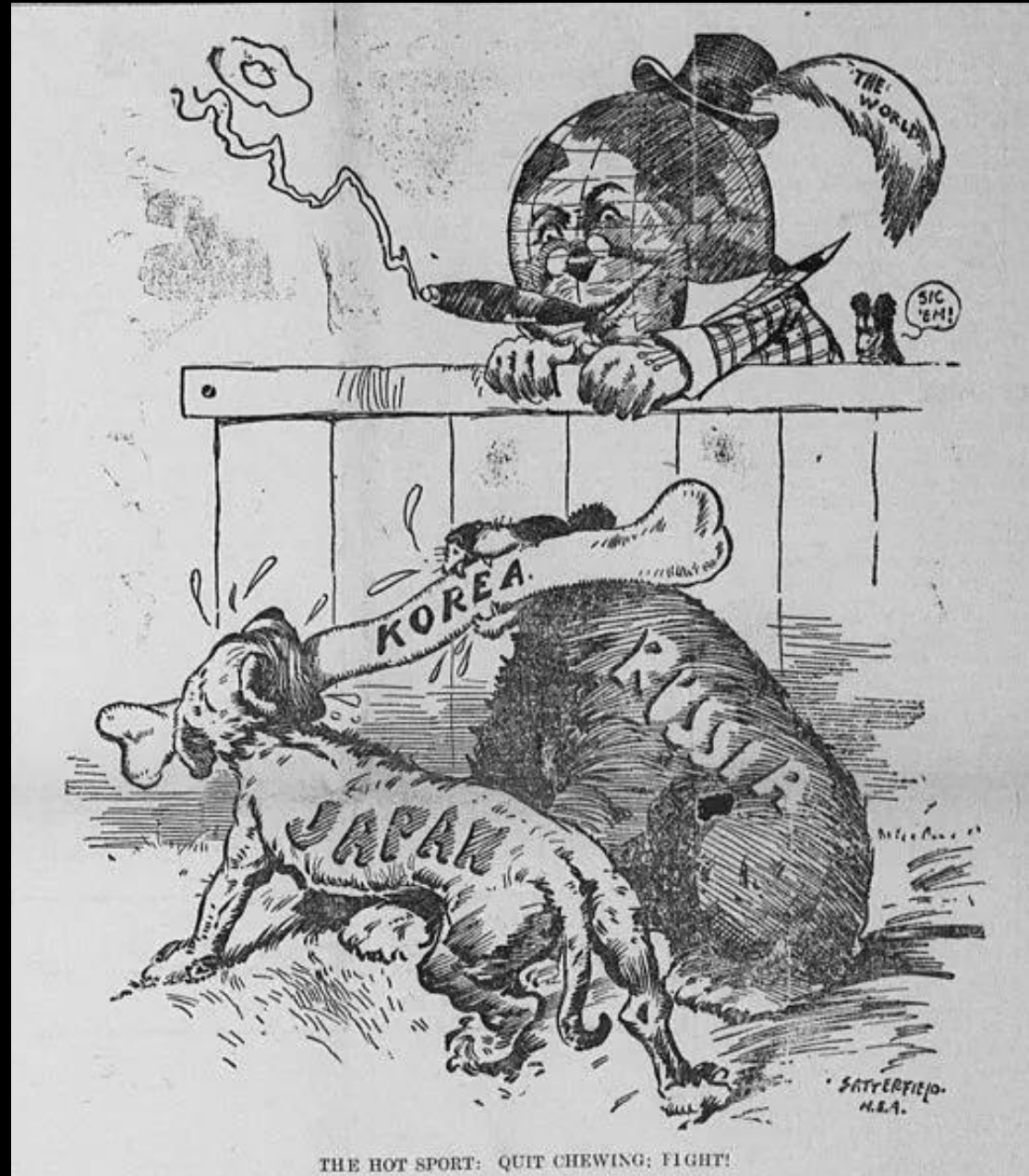

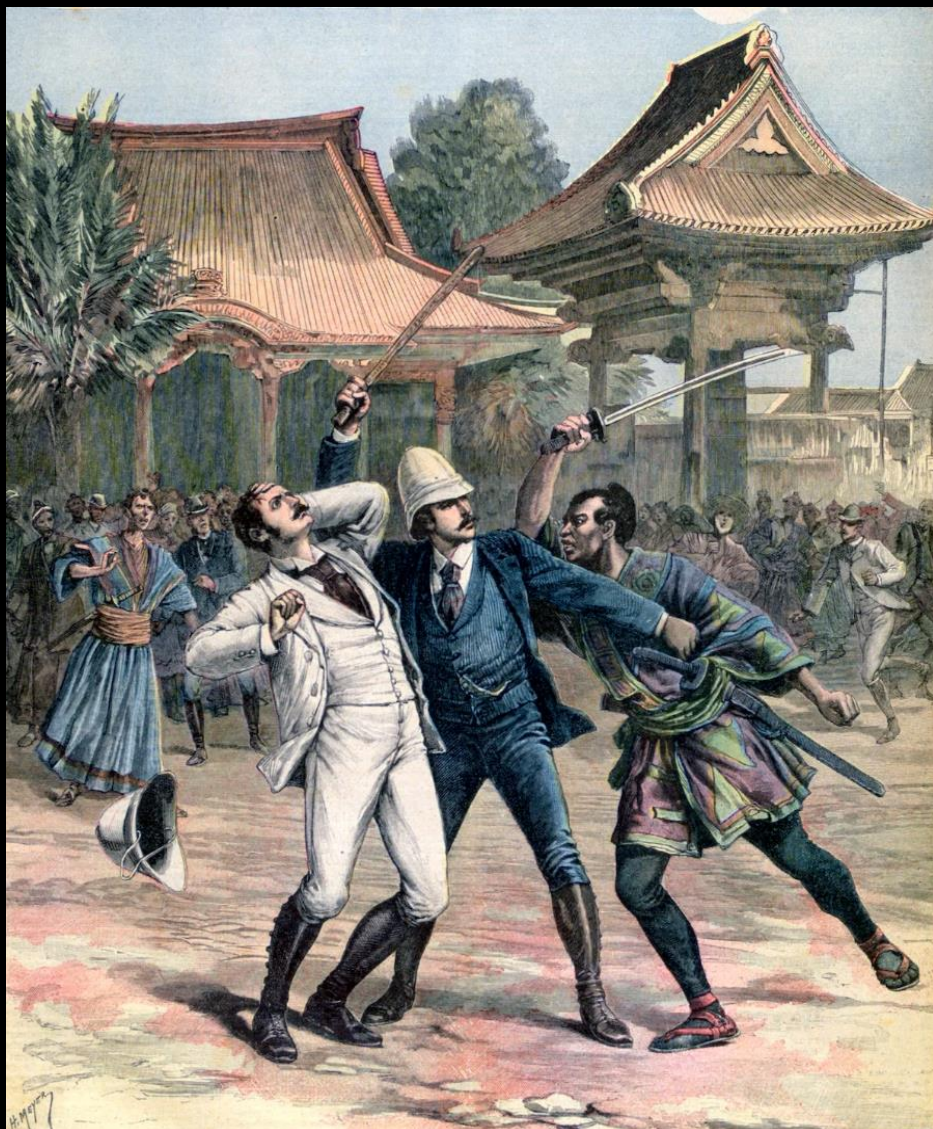

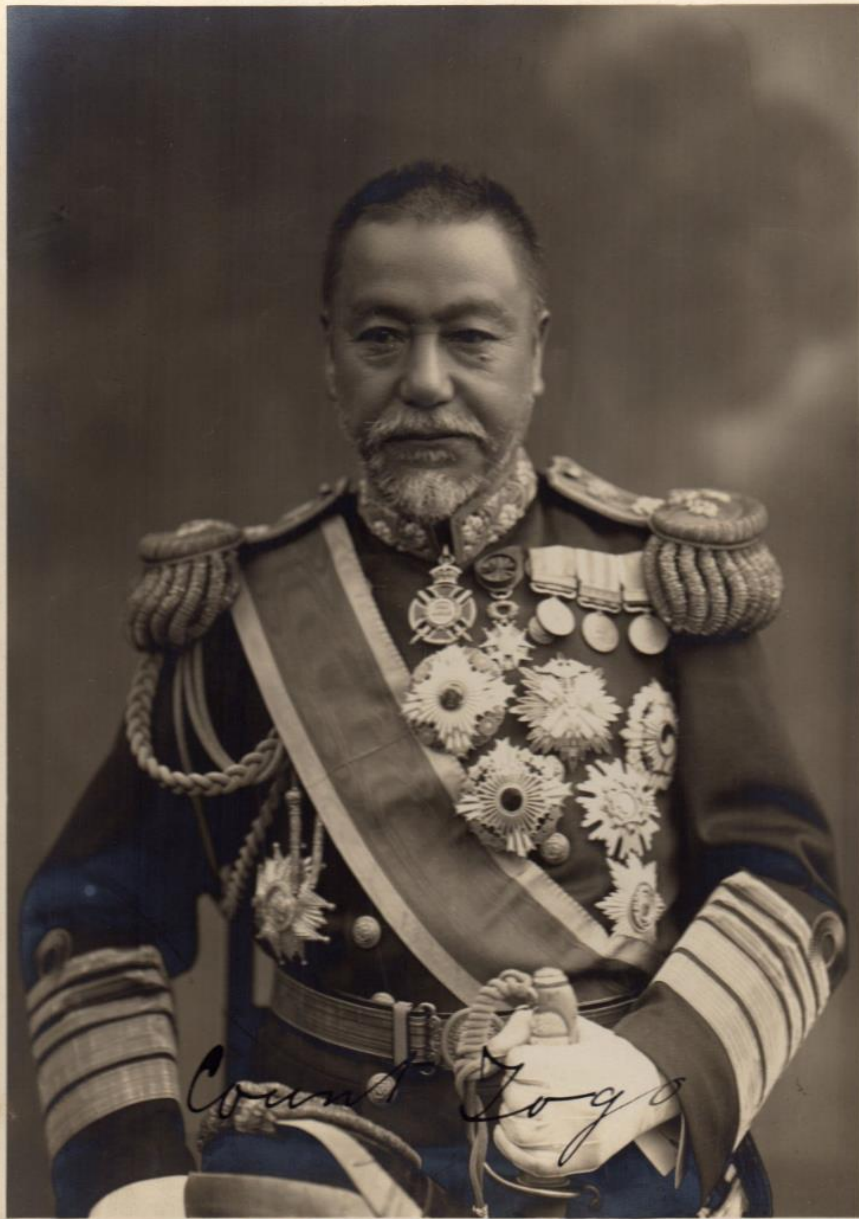

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BATTLE AT PORT ARTHUR.

REPORT FROM ST. PETERSBURG
OF AN ATTACK ON RUSSIAN
SQUADRON BY JAPANESE.

Special to The Reporter.

St. Petersburg, Feb. 9.—Admiral Alexieff reports to the Czar that on midnight of Feb. 8th, nine Japanese torpedo boats attacked the mines of the Russian squadron at the outer roads of Port Arthur and that the battleships Retvizan and Czaravitch and the cruiser Pallada badly damaged.

Japan Took Unresisted Possession of Russian Merchant Vessels and Brought Them to Basebo, Japan—60 Japanese Transports Carrying Troops to Korea—To Occupy Seoul.

London, Feb. 9.—The Chefoo correspondent of the Daily Mail cables that 60 Japanese transports are landing troops at various ports in Korea from Masampo and Fusan on the south to Kusan, Mokpo and Chemulpo on the west.

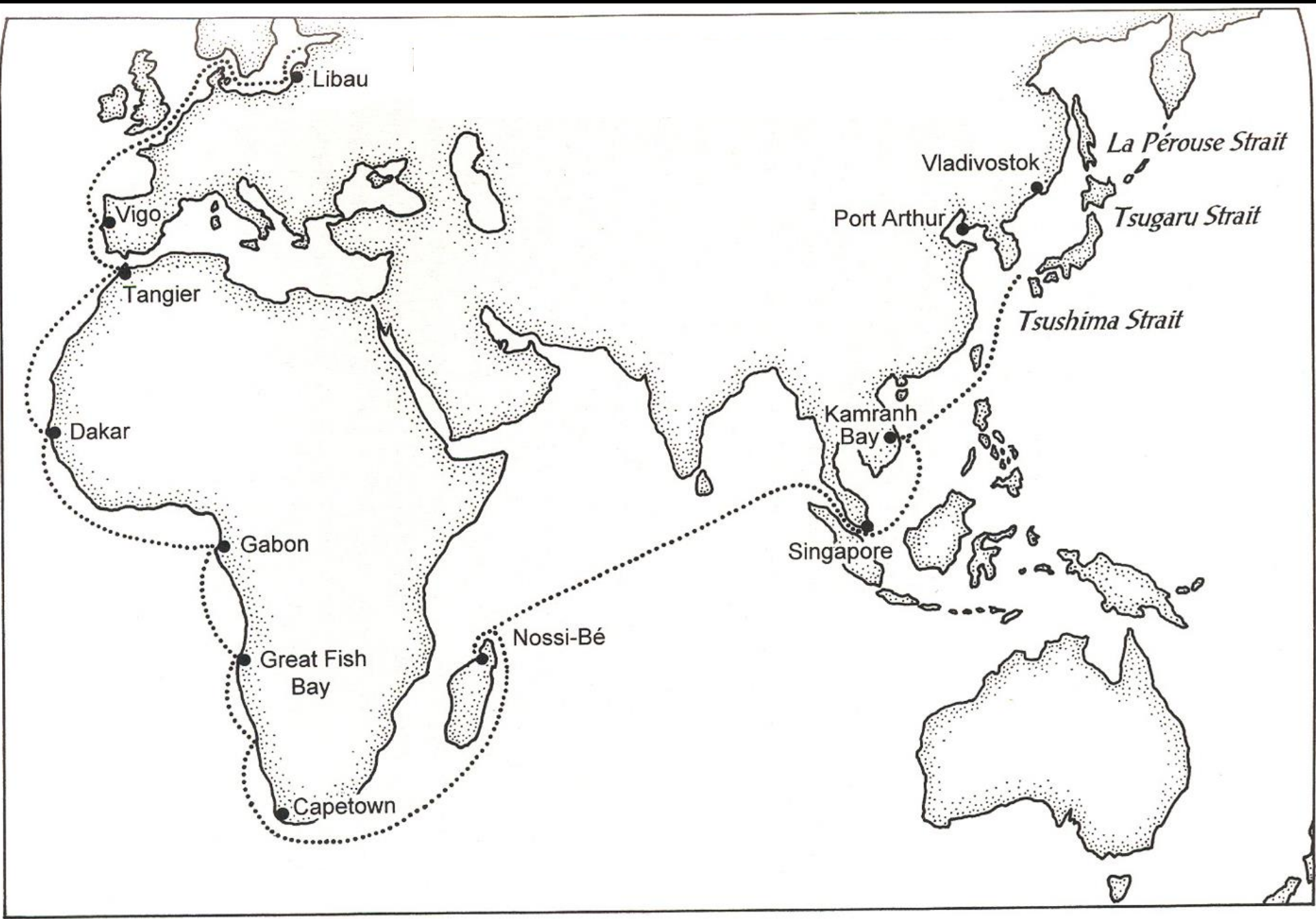

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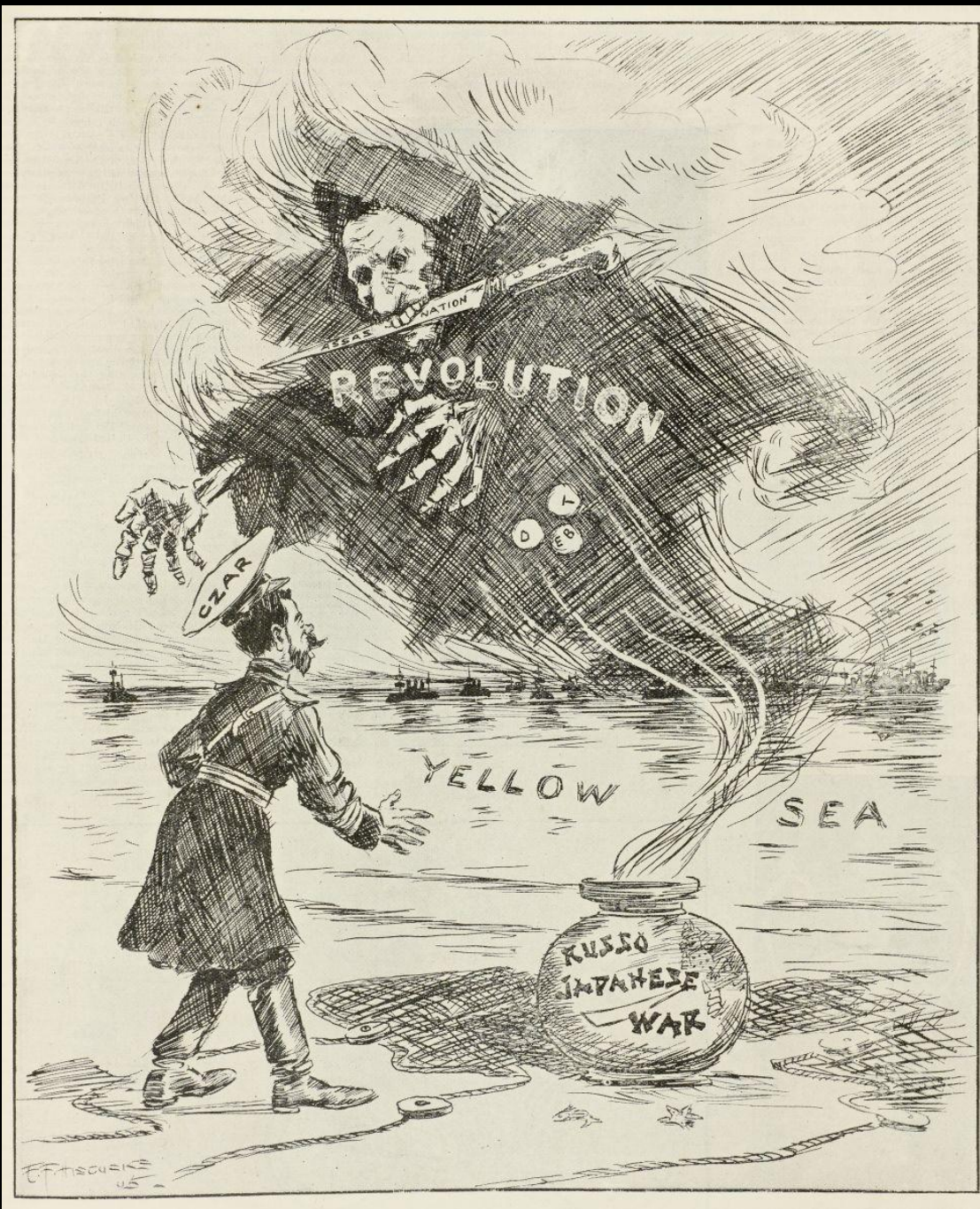
